

DUTY OF CARE FLOWCHART

Waste is defined by the EU Waste Framework Directive as 'any substance or object which the holder discards or intends or is required to discard'. Items that can continue to be used without treatment do not have to be classed as waste.

- Yes if:
1. It is produced as a result of your activity
 2. Or you have a legal responsibility eg hh waste, flytip, litter etc

Use suitable containers to prevent escape and human or environmental risk

- Waste may only be moved by an authorised waste carrier.
- Upper tier for commercial waste collectors and carriers of own construction waste
 - Lower tier for Local Authorities, charities or carriers of own waste

Anything with * on EWC code or which contains hazardous components eg fridge, TV/monitor, flu tube, oily rags etc

Required for any movement regardless of whether carrier produced waste

3 years for consignments – can be completed consignment notes or consignee records
