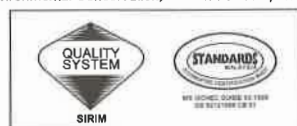
**RE: EXPORTS OF NEW BASEL CONVENTION CODE B3011
PLASTIC WASTES FROM GREAT BRITAIN**

We would like to refer to the above matter and your letter dated 14th January 2021.

2. The Department of Environment (DOE), Malaysia as the Focal Point (FP) and the Competent Authority (CA) of the Basel Convention are aware that the plastic waste amendments to the Basel Convention came into force globally on 1st January 2021. In order to domestically implement the amendments of the Basel Convention Annexes, plastic waste that comply all criteria below is categorized as Code B3011 and to be exempted from the PIC procedure under the Basel Convention: -

- i) Separated plastic waste / without a mixture of plastic resins;
- ii) The plastic contaminant and non-plastic contaminant should not exceed 5%; and
- iii) 95% of the amount of imported plastic waste is recyclable

As a control measure of B3011 movement, we request the country of export through the Basel Competent Authority to submit an information or inspection report that the contents of the shipment to be exported are not waste. An information or inspection report by authorities or by authorized third-party inspection body on the contents of the shipment will be useful to distinguish between plastic waste classified under Annex II or Annex IX of the Basel Convention.
